Bath:

- ☞ Soft baby hair brush and comb
- ☞ Baby shampoo
- ☞ Mild soap (Dove and Ivory)
- ☞ Soft towels/washcloths
- ☞ Baby bath tub
- ☞ Diaper pail
- ☞ Diapers
- ☞ Baby wipes

Bedding:

- ☞ Mattress, waterproof pad
- ☞ Bedding Linens
- ☞ Receiving blankets
- ☞ Baby bunting (if fall / winter)

Financial Planning:

- ☞ Consider a 529 plan

Health and Safety:

- ☞ Thermometer
- ☞ Vaseline, Desitin, A and D ointment
- ☞ Baby Lotion (No Baby Magic or other perfumed lotions)
- ☞ Sun block, SPF \geq 15 for use after 4 months of age
- ☞ Bug-spray (10 - 30% DEET) on clothes only till one year of age.
- ☞ Hat
- ☞ Sunglasses that offer UVA and UVB protection
- ☞ Hypoallergenic laundry detergent (Dreft or All Free and Clear)
- ☞ Monitor
- ☞ Cool mist humidifier
- ☞ Nail clippers, nail file or emery boards
- ☞ Bulb syringe/ Nose Frieda
- ☞ Doctors Phone #, Local pharmacy phone number, Poison Control # (1800-222-1222) and 911 posted by the phones and on your cell phones
